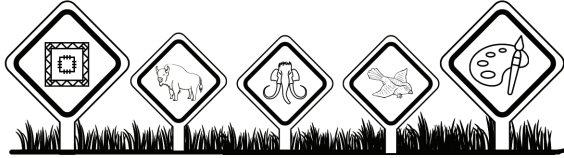


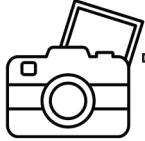

Schramm State Park
